

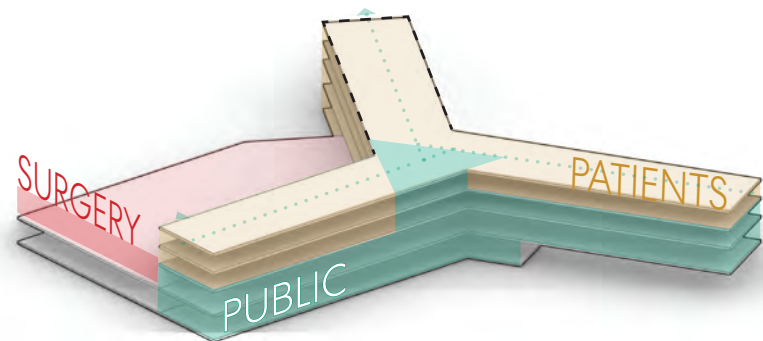

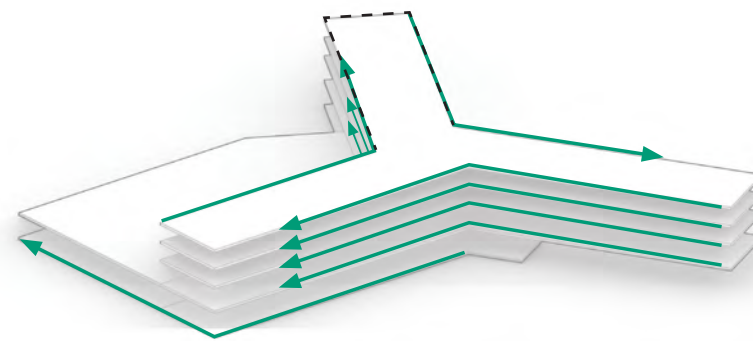
Bringing a sense of place and scale to Health and Well-Being

The 'Strata' design of the new Atrium Union West Hospital embodies the many layered history of Stallings, North Carolina, a small farming town in transition to a bedroom community for metropolitan Charlotte. Its broad, three-story composition and earth-toned materials are inspired by the agrarian context and reduce the perceived scale of the hospital, helping it communicate with its surrounding community.



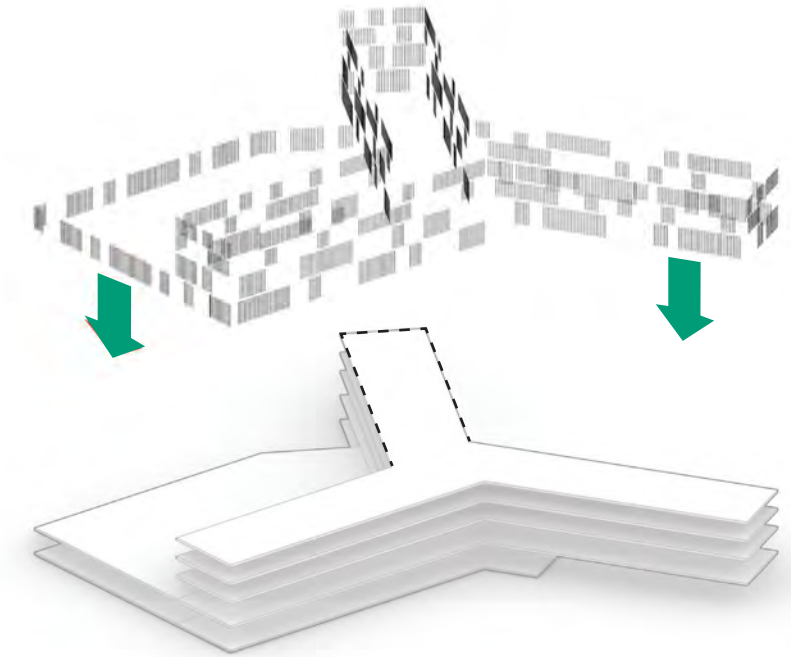
The 'Prototype'

A new standardized model for patient care units prescribes narrower, end-loaded patient wings enhancing patient visibility and response time, reducing staff while all maximizing natural daylighting and views.



Contextual Relationship

Composing the structure to a sensible scale to communicate with its surrounding context. The 'Strata' reflects that of Stallings 'Many Layered' history, a beacon that serves as the local communities hub for Health & Well-Being.



Textured Poetics

Reflecting the Town of Stallings Agrarian past through furrowed landscapes and textured facades forming a healthcare experience that is unique, one that has a 'sense of place'

SITE PLAN

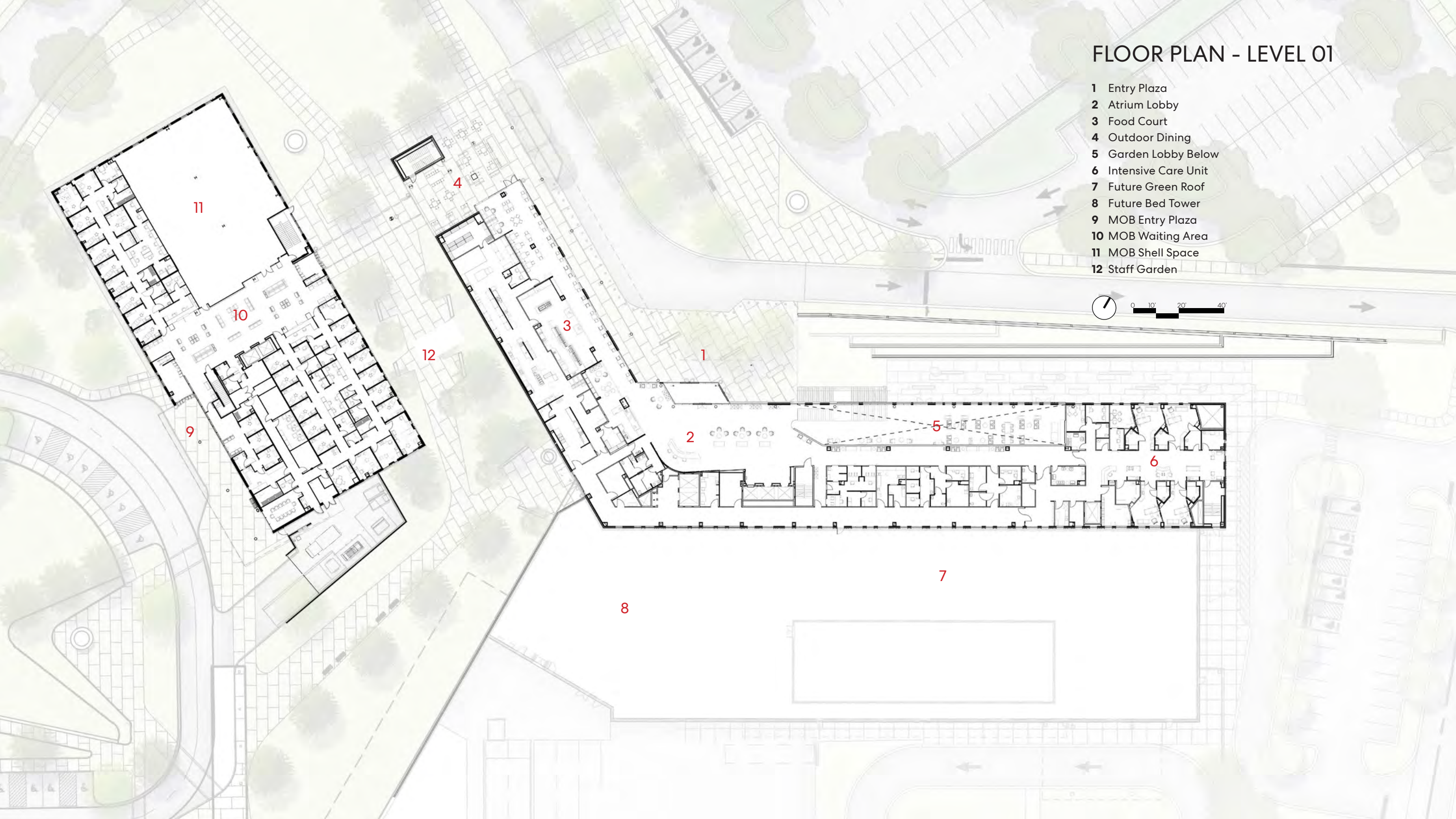
The overall form of the new hospital is derived from the client's standardized model for patient care units. It prescribes narrower, end-loaded patient wings with a more open, centralized nursing commons. This standard permitted a pinwheel arrangement around a central atrium lobby.

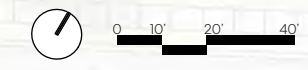
