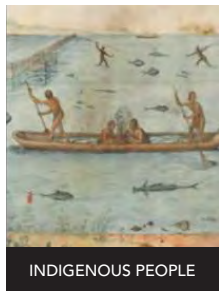

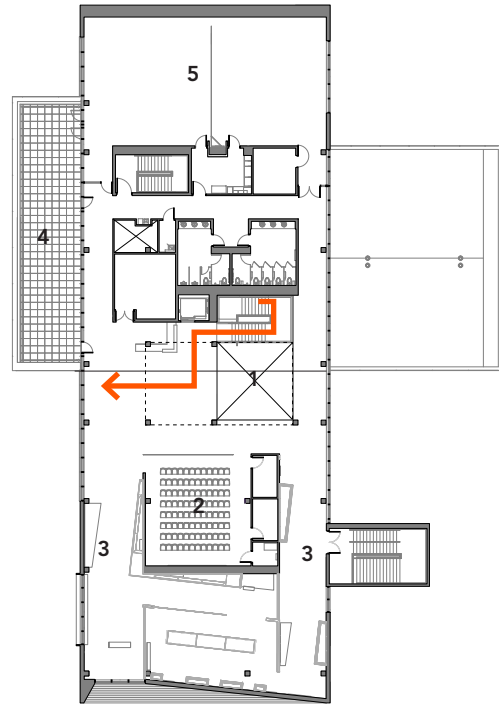

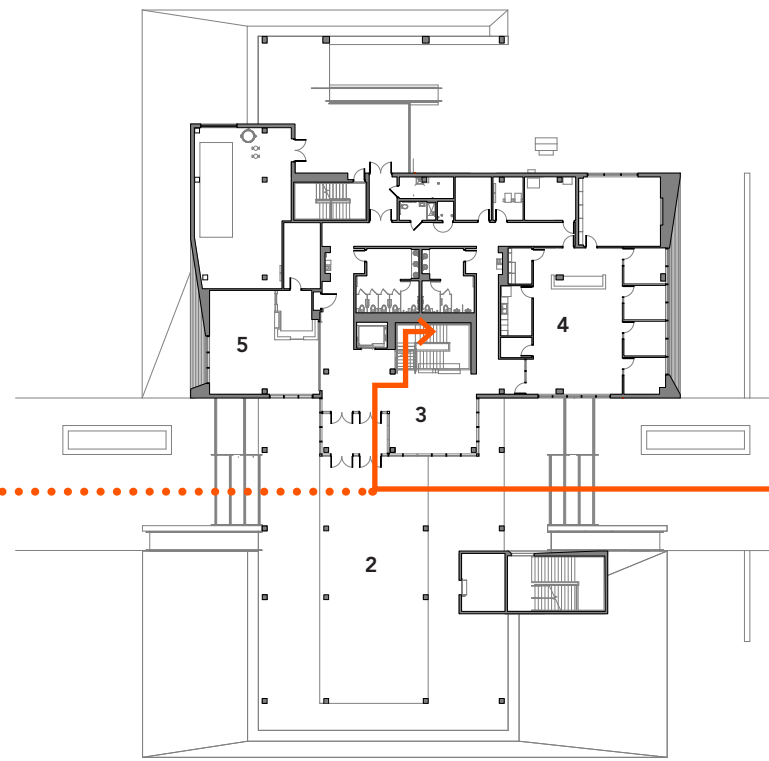

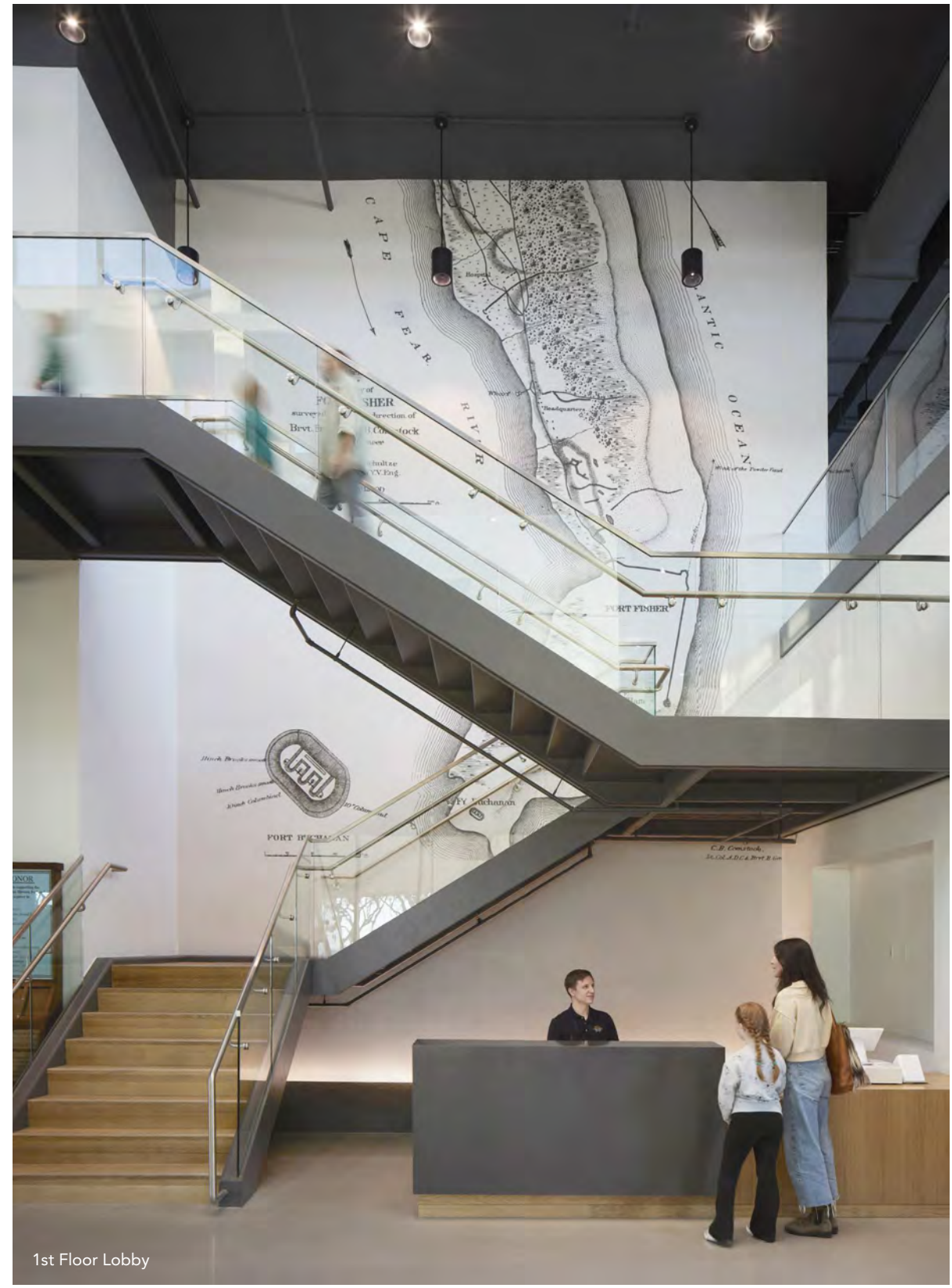
⊖ SECOND FLOOR PLAN

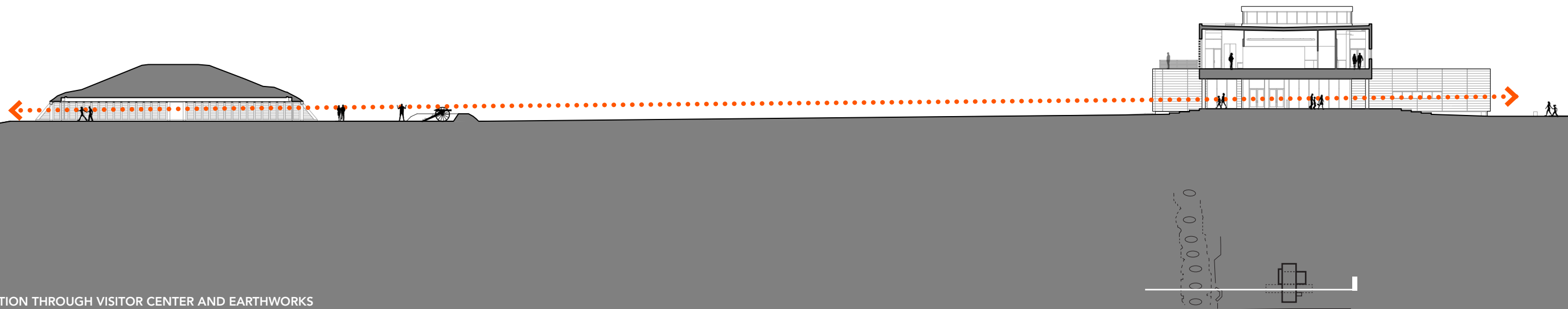

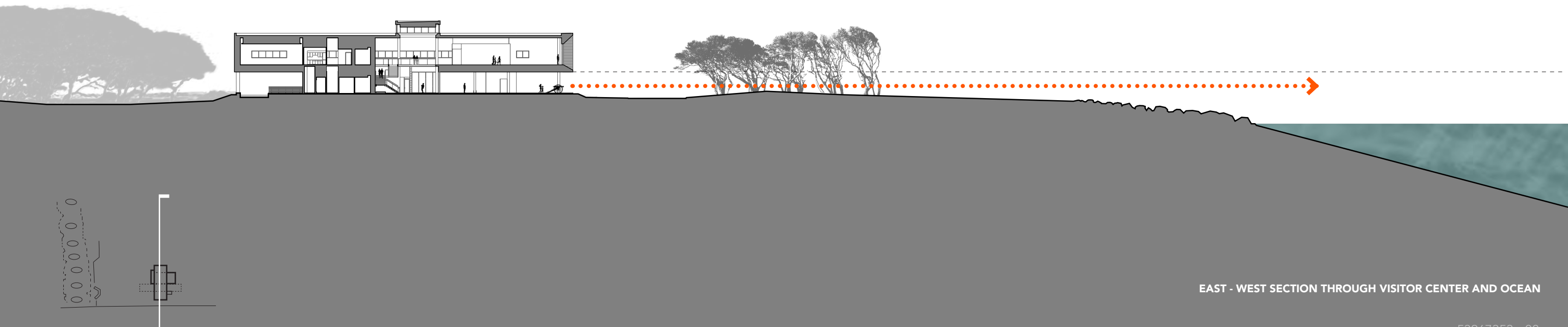
