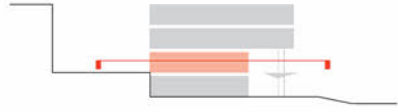
DETAIL ELEVATION

At the U.S. Air Force Academy, architectural design emphasizes functionality and adaptability to meet modern Air Force requirements. The foundational guideline requires adherence to the USAFA's standard 7-foot grid module, which can be divided into smaller increments. This ensures long-term flexibility, allowing facilities to adjust to evolving operational and educational needs.

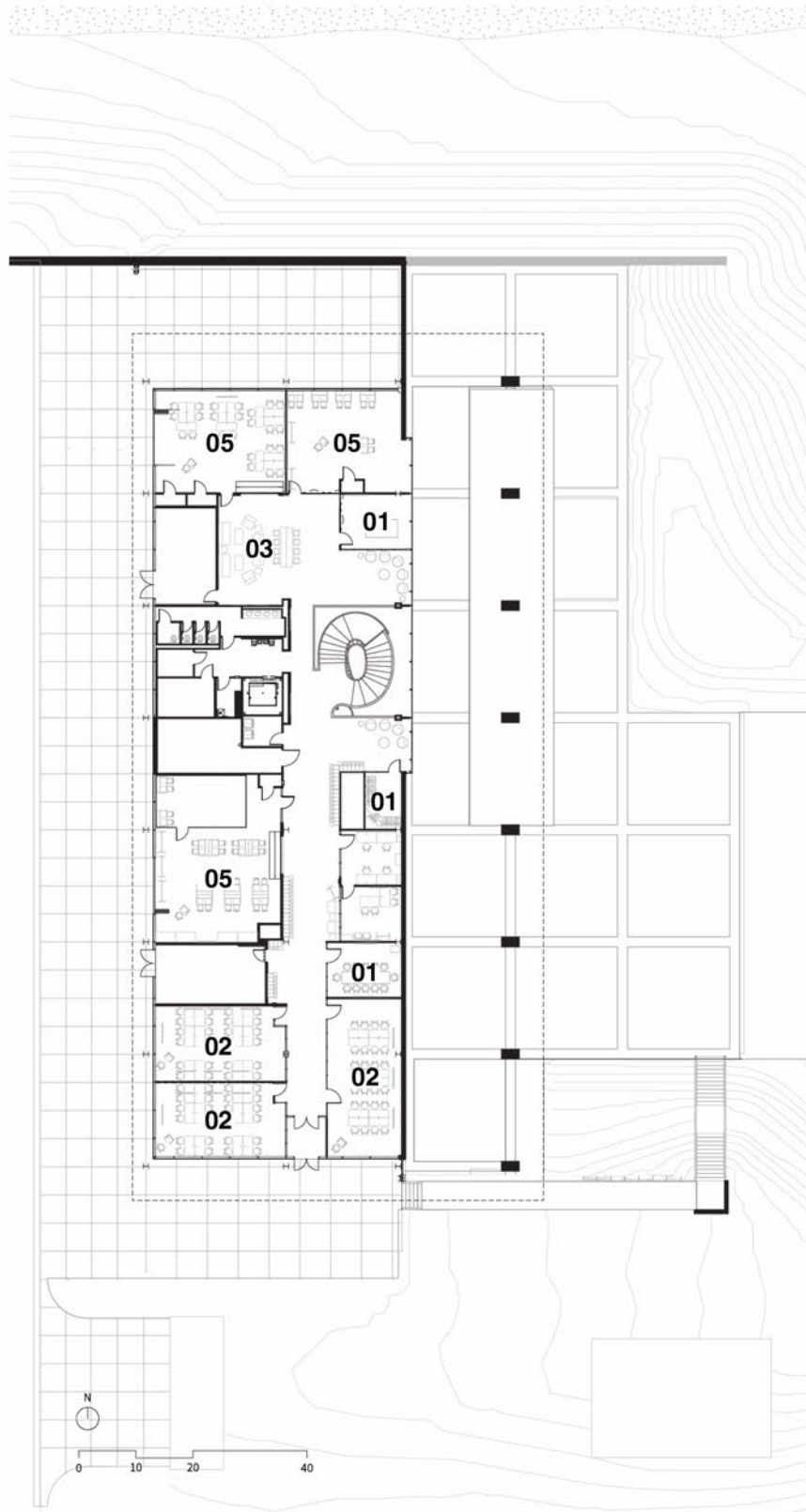

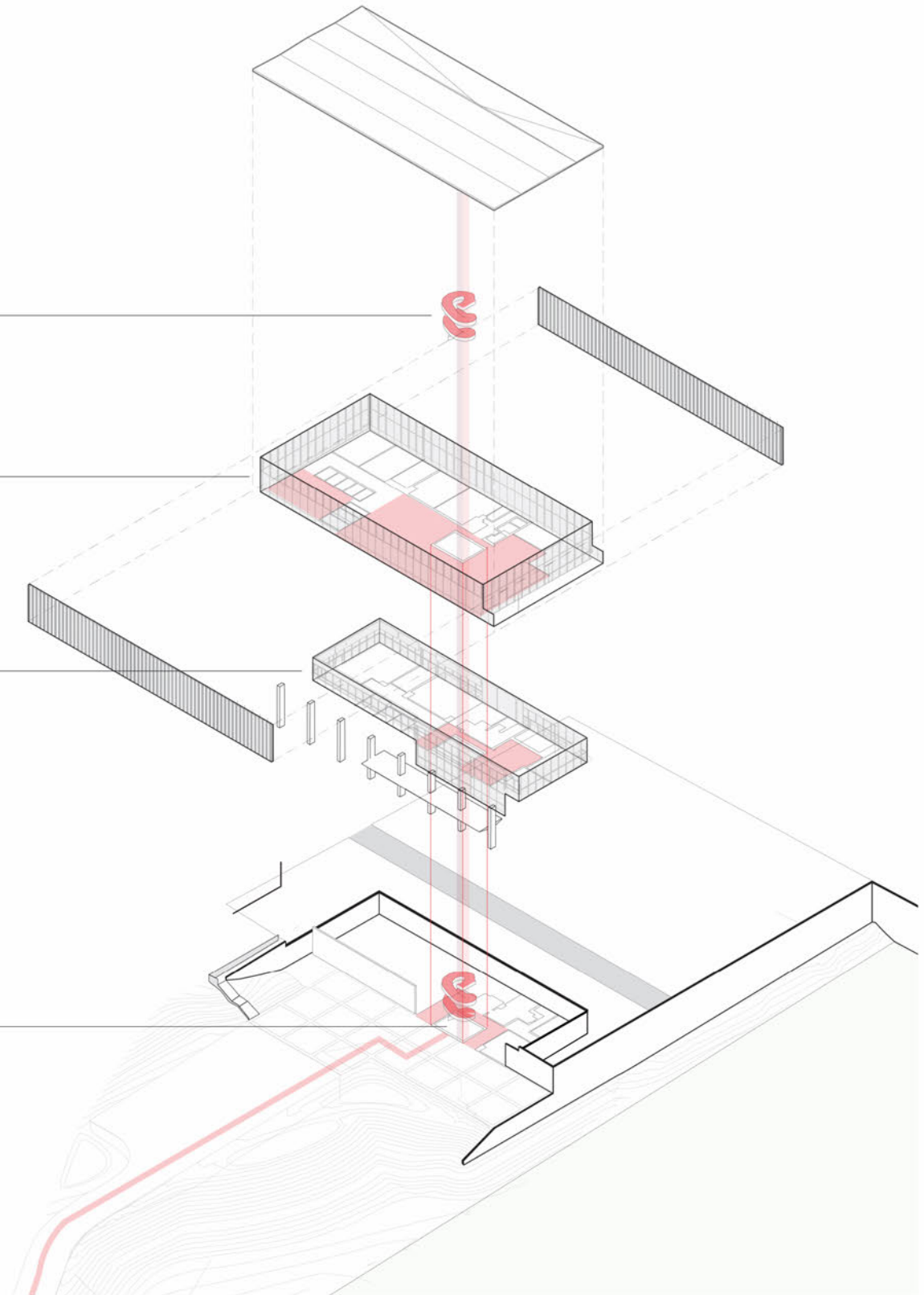
Central Stair
